Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC) in Education Settings

You may be aware from media coverage that the government has asked some schools to close or partially close due to the presence of reinforced autoclaved aerated concrete (RAAC) in their school buildings. We understand that this is an unsettling news story and that it may naturally have led you to wonder about the safety of our school building.

As a school, we have reviewed the relevant DfE guidance and from our review of Local Authority school survey, completed by the County Structural Engineer in 2019, there is no RAAC construction identified within our school buildings.

I hope that this provides reassurance, and we look forward to welcoming your child to our safe and secure learning environment.

Start of the School Year Information

Times of the School Day

- School day starts at 8.25a.m. and finishes at 2.55p.m.
- The main school gates will be opened at 8.15a.m. and at 2.50p.m. each day for access to the site.

Entry and Exit from School

Morning Drop-off

School gates opened at 8.15a.m. each day.

- Cygnets parents and children walk round the playground to Cygnets building.
- Year 1 and 2 parents and children walk round the playground to the external fenced area by classrooms.
- Year 3 and 4 children are to line up on playground.
- Year 5 and 6 children are to go straight into classrooms through the main teaching block door and Year 6 classroom door.

A member of school staff will welcome children at respective entrances each day.

Exit from school site for all parents and children will be through the main entrance by the School Office.

End of Day Arrangements

Gates will be opened at **2.50p.m.** for parents to enter the site.

- **Cygnets parents** to wait by the small playground near Cygnets building. Parents to collect their children from the member of staff on the Cygnets building door; this will give daily opportunity for staff to pass on messages as required, at the end of the day.
- Year 1 and 2 children will line up in external garden area for collection.
- Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 children will line up on playground for collection.

Parents need to inform the school office on every occasion, if collection arrangements are changed for children for the end of the day.

Medication, Inhalers and Emergency Medication

- Children who need inhalers must bring these in to school on the first day of the term.
- Please can parents inform the school office of any medical conditions that may require medication during the school day. The school office will also support in completion of administration of medicine forms as required.
- Any prescribed medicine needed by children, must be given to the School Office, not to class teachers.

Breakfast Club and After School Club

Extended provision will begin before and after school as from Tuesday 5th September.

- Breakfast Club runs from 7.45a.m. to 8.25a.m. drop off at School Office.
- After School Club runs from 2.45p.m. to 4.30p.m. or 5.30p.m. (please note that due to staffing, these are the only collection times available) - collection of children from after school club will be from the School Reception Area.

School Uniform and Equipment Needed

Physical Education and Forest School

Children should come to school each day with:

- Coat
- Named water bottle these will be sent home daily
- Sunhat and suncream (if the weather is good) N.B. children need to be able to apply suncream themselves or have it applied by parents before school
- Packed lunch box if needed
- Jewellery: children are welcome to wear watches each day. They are also welcome to wear plain stud earrings. No other jewellery should be worn.

(Please note that watches will need to be removed and earrings taped or removed by children, for every PE lesson)

- Long hair must be tied back
- All resources such as pens, pencils, rulers will be provided (however, children in Year 4-6 can bring pencil cases into school if they would like)
- Children should not bring toys into school.
